We promise to listen with an open, nonjudgmental mind to the words and ideas of others in our Church.

We promise to discuss, debates and disagree openly in meetings, expressing ourselves as clearly and honestly as possible, so that we are certain that there understand our point of view.

We promise to support the final decision when it is made, whether it reflects our view or not.
